PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RANKING SYSTEM (PNRS)

1. The PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RANKING SYSTEM or PNRS is a list of Philippine players / pairs in order of strength. There is one list for each of the five Badminton events in the PNRS (mens singles, womens singles, mens doubles, womens doubles and mixed doubles).
2. Players / pairs:
 - a. win ranking points by playing in tournaments that are officially sanctioned by the Philippine Badminton Association.
 - b. are ranked if they have played in at least two or more graded tournaments in the last 52 weeks.
 - c. win ranking points by playing in and winning matches in tournaments
 - d. the higher the level of tournament, the more points are won.
 - e. the further the progress reached in a competition, the more points are won.
 - f. can be seeded based on their PNRS ranking.
3. There is no team ranking in the PNRS, only players and pairs.
4. There will be a separate ranking for open players and junior players (19 years old and under)
5. The PNRS shall commence on 1 January 2014.
6. The following are the tournaments officially sanctioned by the PBA to be part of the Philippine National Badminton Circuit (PNBC):

b. Junior Tournaments

1. Suncellular Junior National

7. The officially sanctioned tournaments may be increased or decreased based upon a decision of the Board of Trustees of the PBA and published in a newspaper of general circulation. All officially sanctioned tournaments will be posted in the PBA website together with their respective prospectus.

8. The PNRS are compiled from the results of tournaments that are sanctioned by the PBA participated in by the player/pair and held over the last 52 week period.

9. A junior player may opt to participate in Open tournaments. Players older than 17 years old and one day and under nineteen years old can opt to have separate junior and open rankings.

10. Players/pairs win points according to how far they progress in the draw of a particular event.

If a player/pair:

a. had a bye in the first round and lost in the second round – they receive first round loser's points.

b. had a bye in the first round, won in the second round and lost in the third round – they receive third round loser's points.

c. had a walkover in the first round and lost in the second round – they receive second round loser's points.

d. had a bye in the first round, walkover in the second round and lost in the third round – they receive third round loser's points.

e. in tournament levels 3 & 4 had a wildcard entry and lost in the first round they receive no ranking points.
