



# 2018 PHILIPPINE NATIONAL GAMES

## BADMINTON GENERAL INFORMATION

### 1. **ORGANIZER**

The Philippine Olympic Committee and the Philippine Sports Commission in partnership with the **PHILIPPINE BADMINTON ASSOCIATION SMASH PILIPINAS.**

### 2. **DATE AND VENUE**

**2.1** Dates: May 19-25, 2018 **2.2** Venue: Metrosports Badminton Center, Salinas Drive, Lahug, Cebu City

### **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRIES**

1. The 2018 Philippine National Games is a multi-sport competition for Filipinos **aged 16 years and above. Athletes born in the year 2002 and before** may participate.
2. An athlete should participate as a member of the official delegation of a province or chartered city. Municipal and barangay-level endorsements of athletes shall NOT be accepted.
3. An athlete should be a Filipino citizen, whether by birth or naturalization. A Fil-foreign athlete may participate as long as he/she represents a particular LGU (birthplace of Filipino parent).
4. Team shall composed of maximum four (4) Mens and four (4) Womens per LGU.
5. A maximum of two (2) event per player.
6. No ID, No play shall be implemented.
7. Players are advise to be in the playing venue at least 30 minutes before their schedule match.
8. Coaches shall make a letter of information or explanation in case their cannot play and must submit to Tournament Director.
9. Participation in the PNG is for free (no entry/participation fee to be collected).

### **II. FORMS AND DOCUMENTS FOR SUBMISSION**

1. PNG Entry Form A (Entry by Number per Sport) certified by the LGU Head or Administrator indicating the numbers of the following:
  - a. Participating athletes per sport
  - b. Coaches per sport
  - c. Delegation officials
2. PNG Entry Form A-1 (Entry by Number per Event)
3. PNG Entry Form B (Entry by Name per Event) with affixed LGU dry seal indicating the following:
  - a. Names of participating athletes per event (based on birth certificate)
  - a. Ages of participating athletes per event
4. Medical Clearance and Waiver of Liability Form to be signed by the athlete and a licensed physician
5. Certified true copy of athlete’s birth certificate issued by the National Statistics Office or the local Civil Registrar
6. **The following deadlines shall be strictly enforced:**

Participating LGUs may submit their PNG Entry Forms A and A-1 only once. Submitted PNG Entry Forms A and A-1 must contain all the requested data or these will NOT be acknowledged. Failure to comply with deadline of submission for PNG Entry Forms A and A-1 will disqualify the LGU from access to PNG Entry Form B and participation in the games. Participating LGUs may submit their PNG Entry Form B only once. Submitted LGU Entry Forms B must contain all the requested data or these will NOT be acknowledged. A delegation’s PNG Entry Form B must also reflect the same or less number of delegates provided in its submitted PNG Entry Forms A and A-1. Supporting documents such as Medical Clearance, Waiver of Liability Form and Birth Certificates of participating athletes shall be sent via courier to the following postal address:

7. Substitution of athletes shall be allowed only if the athlete is to be replaced because of injury/illness and his/her substitute is playing the same event. Substitution of athletes for other reasons shall NOT be allowed. Substitution of athletes on-site will NOT be accepted. Substitution of athletes qualified for the National Finals will NOT be allowed.
8. Late submission of entries and on-site registration will NOT be allowed.

- 2.3 An athlete should participate as a member of the official delegation of a province or chartered city. Municipal and barangay-level endorsements of athletes shall NOT be accepted
- 2.4 Players must be of good standing with the Philippine Badminton Association

### 4. **COMPETITION RULES & SCHEDULE**

- 5.1 The tournament will be run in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Badminton World Federation and the Philippine Badminton Association. The format will be single elimination in all categories and events.

### 5. **SHUTTLECOCKS**

Feather Shuttlecocks of BWF Standard for Tournaments

### 6. **SCORING SYSTEM**

- a. The current BWF 1-21 rally point scoring system will be used in all categories and events.

### 7. **DEFAULTING TIME**

A three (3) minutes grace period shall be given.

### 8. **SEEDING AND DRAW**

- a. The seeding of players will be based on the results of this year's latest PBA organized or sanctioned national tournaments, but the information must be indicated properly in the player's entry form.
- b. Draws will be done electronically using the tournament software on **May 18, 2018**.
- c. The team managers' meeting shall be held in the afternoon of **May 18, 2018** at MetroSports Badminton Center.
- d. Representatives of participating LGU are invited to witness the draw.

### 9. **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES, TEAM AND TECHNICAL OFFICIALS**

- a. A coach or a team official who is taking the seat to coach during a match shall:
  - b. Coaches' Attire: Coaches are required to wear shirt and pants / tokong below the knee when seated. Slippers, sandals, sleeveless shirts are not allowed.
  - c. Must remain seated in the designated chairs provided at each end of the court behind his / her player(s) except at the approved intervals.
- 9.1 Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way to distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- d. Must not bring the sport into disrepute through media comments relating to technical officials either pre or post match that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question the integrity of the technical officials in charge of the match or tournament.
  - e. Coaches are team leaders, they shall be held accountable for the discipline of their respective teams. HEALTH AND FITNESS The Team Managers/Coaches or Delegation Heads are responsible for the fitness of its athletes. Waves any right to claim damages against the Organizers for injuries its athletes may incur in the process of their participation in the Philippine National Games (PNG)
- 9.2 In the case of flagrant breaches of this Code of Conduct, the Umpire will call the Referee to the court. The Referee will remove the offending Coach / Team Official from the coaching floor or removed from the arena for the remainder of the event or part thereof.

### 10. **BILLETING**

Billeting will be arrange by PSC, Athletes, Coaches and Technical Official are advised to bring their own mattress and beddings..

### 11. **PRIZES**

- a. Prizes shall be provided by the Organizing Committee for distribution to the
  - i. Champion: Medals and Certificate
  - ii. 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up: Medals and Certificate
  - iii. Two 2<sup>nd</sup> Runners-up: Medals and Certificate

### 12. **INDEMNITY**

The Organizing Committee and its appointed officials shall not be held responsible for any injuries or mishaps that may occur during the competition or as a result of participation in the tournament.

### 13. **OTHER MATTERS**

In all other matters not covered by the preceding rules, the decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final.
