GUIDELINES:

1. Competition Area:

10 x10 meters + 1 meter safety area all sides.

2. Protective gear:

Required protective gears are: Mouth guard, red and blue gloves, red and blue belt, red and blue shin guards with instep and Body protector.

Note: Protective gears must be WKF approved or approved by organizing committee for safety.

2. Duration of bouts:

2 Minutes for juniors and female and 3 minutes for men's seniors.

Note: Duration of bout means fighting time and does not include stopped time.

3. Contact:

FACE CONTACT FOR SENIORS: For Senior competitors, non-injurious, light, controlled "touch" contact to the face, head, and neck is allowed (but not to the throat).

FACE CONTACT FOR JUNIORS: For Junior competitors no contact to the head, face, or neck, is allowed with hand techniques. Any contact, no matter how light, will be penalized. Jodan kicks may make the lightest touch ("skin touch") and still score. Any more than a skin touch will require a warning or penalty unless caused by the recipient (MUBOBI).
