3.3 Players must submit a copy of their NSO birth certificate or any legal document that will certify their age such as passport.

3.4 Players may be entered in a maximum of two (2) events.

5. COMPETITION RULES & SCHEDULE

7. SCORING SYSTEM

7.1 The current BWF rally point scoring system will be used in all categories and events.

8. SEEDING AND DRAW

8.1 The seeding of players will be based on the results of this year's latest PBA organized or sanctioned national tournaments, but the information must be indicated properly in the player's entry fonn.

8.2 Draw will be done electronically using the tournament software On July 1, 2015 during the Team Manager's Meeting starting at 3 pm at the PSC Badminton Hall, RMSC, Malat~, Manila

8.3 Representatives of participating clubs and teams are invited to witness the draw.

9. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES, TEAM AND TECHNICAL OFFICIALS

9.1 A coach or a team official who is taking the seat to coach during a match shall:

9.2 Be dressed appropriately and must remain seated in the designated chairs provided at each end of the court behind his / her player(s) except at the approved intervals.

9.3. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture towards or in any other way to distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player.

9.4. Must not bring the sport into disrepute through media comments relating to technical officials either pre or post match that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question the integrity of the technical officials in charge of the match or tournament.

9.5. In the case of flagrant breaches of this Code of Conduct, the Umpire will call the Referee to the court. The Referee will remove the offending Coach / Team Official from the coaching floor or removed from the arena for the remainder of the event or part thereof.

10. BILLETING

Billeting will be arranged in the nearby school near PSC.
