1. Proposed Schedule of Events

2. Competition Rules:

The Fencing competition in the POC-PSC National Games is open to Filipino Nationals aged 16 years old and above (born 1999 or earlier). The competition will be held in accordance with the rules for fencing of the Federation International d'Esgrime (FIE), in force during the Games. In case of any disagreement in the interpretation of the Rules, the English version shall prevail.

Equipment: Fencing jackets and breeches should be at least 350 NW. Underplastron of at least 350 NW will be required in Epee. Weapons check will start 1 hour before start of competition.

3. Competition Format:

Individual Events

The Individual competition shall be conducted in one or more rounds of elimination pools, eliminating 20-30 percent to qualify the remaining fencers into the direct elimination.

Team Events

The Team competition will be limited to only one (1) team per Club or LGU. The seeding in the Team Events will take into account the individual results achieved by the competitors representing each Club or LGU participating in the Individual Events.

There will be one gold, one silver and two bronzes to be awarded in each Individual Event and medals will also be awarded to one gold, one silver and two bronze finishers in the Team Events.

6 Gold Medals for Individual Events
6 Silver medals for Individual Events
12 Bronze medals for Individual Events

24 Gold Medals for Team Events
24 Silver Medals for Team Events
48 Bronze Medals for Team Events
