Article 1. ORGANIZATION

- 1.1 The Road Cycling Competitions of the 2023 Philippine National Games (PNG) and Batang Pinoy National Championships are organized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC).
- 1.2 The competitions are supervised by the Integrated Cycling Federation of the Philippines (PhilCycling), the national association of the sport recognized by the PSC and the Philippine Olympic Committee.

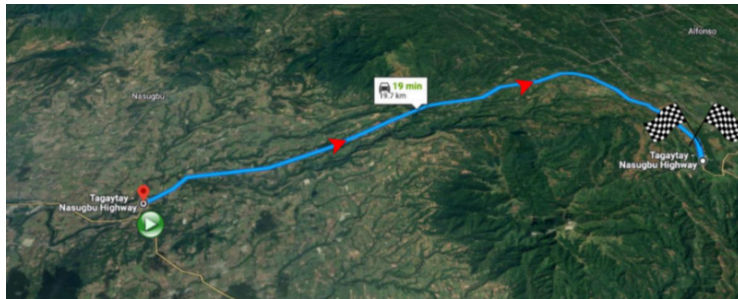

Article 12. MUSTERING AND SIGN ON

All riders/cyclists must present themselves for Sign On and Mustering One (01) Hour before the start of each event.

Article 13. STARTING ORDER IN ITT and START PROCEDURE FOR INDIVIDUAL ROAD RACE

12. 1 THE starting order for the Individual Time Trial (ITT) races shall be composed by the commissaires and communicated through the Philippine Sports Commission. In the ITT, the start interval will be one minute.

Article 14. BICYCLES AND EQUIPMENT CONTROL

14.1 Standard Road Bikes shall be used in all categories and events.

14.2 Aerobars are allowed in ITT races, but disc wheels and aero helmets are not permitted.

14.3 All riders/cyclists must present their equipment for inspection by commissaires One (01) Hour before the start of competitions.

14.4 Gear ratios shall not be applied.

Article 15. NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT

Technical support shall be provided by Three (03) neutral vehicles only during the Individual Road Race.



Article 16. FEEDING AND TEAM SUPPORT

16.1 Feeding shall be allowed at a designated pit during the Criterium Races.

16.2 There shall be no feeding during ITT races.

16.3 Static hydration/feeding stations will be located at specified sections of the Individual Road Races.

16.4 Team support for Technical Assistance/Recognized Mishaps/Mechanical Issues shall be at a designated location in the Criterium Races.

16.5 Team support on motorcycles are not allowed in any and all of the races/events except for recognized mishaps or mechanical issues.

Article 17. CURFEW

Time limit for Individual Road Races is 10 percent.

Article 18. AWARDS CEREMONIES AND MEDIA INTERVIEWS

18.1 The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placers shall be awarded the gold, silver and bronze medals.

18.2 The awarding ceremonies shall take place no more than 30 minutes after the Official Result for each category/event was signed by the Chief Judge.

18.3 The Top 3 placers shall make themselves immediately available for the Medal Ceremony and shall wear their complete jerseys. Fines shall be slapped on the teams and coaches whose athletes are not available during the medal ceremony.

18.3 All riders/cyclists specially the Top 3 placers in all events and categories shall make themselves available for media interviews.

Article 19. ANTI-DOPING

ANTI-DOPING controls according to the regulations of the UCI will be announced.



Article 20. CLOTHING

Clothing shall only be UCI-regulation—jerseys, shorts and socks (must not exceed the halfway mark between the edge of the angles and the bottom of the knees). Regulation helmets are mandatory. Unauthorized clothing or apparel is forbidden.

Article 21. PENALTIES

Penalties shall be applied in accordance with the UCI regulations.

Article 22. WASTE DISPOSAL

Riders caught throwing empty bottles, peels, trash or the shall will be disqualified. Coaches and team officials and staff caught littering shall be fined.

Article 23. PROTESTS

Protests shall be in written form and filed within 30 minutes after the first rider has crossed the finish line and with a corresponding fee of PhP _____ to be filed with the Philippine Sports Commission PNG and Batang Pinoy Secretariat. All protests will be decided on site by the Panel of Commissaires.

Article 24. RESPONSIBILITIES

24.1 The PSC and the PhilCycling shall not, under any circumstances, be liable to any accidents or damage that occurs during training and competitions.

24.2 For all cases not covered by these specific regulations, the UCI rules will apply.

MOUNTAIN BIKE

Article 1. ORGANIZATION

- 1.1 The Mountain Bike & BMX Competitions of the 2023 Philippine National Games (PNG) and Batang Pinoy National Championships are organized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC).
- 1.2 The competitions are supervised by the Integrated Cycling Federation of the Philippines (PhilCycling), the national association of the sport recognized by the PSC and the Philippine Olympic Committee.
- 1.3 Competition Venue for 2023 shall be in Indang, Cavite.

Article 3. PARTICIPATION

- 3.1 The events are open to Riders/Cyclists representing their respective Local Government Units (LGUs—city or province).
- 3.2 LGUs shall register their athletes online through a PSC-designated portal.
- 3.3 An LGU shall enter a maximum of Two (02) athletes per category and event.
- 3.4 An athlete/rider/cyclist shall participate in no more than Two (02) events.

Article 4. CROSS-COUNTRY OLYMPIC (XCO) FORMAT

4.2.001 The duration and lap length of cross-country Olympic event in the different race classifications in the table below must lie within the following ranges or as close as possible to the race length (in hours and minutes).

4.2.002 The course for a cross-country Olympic event should use an attractive lay-out to encourage easy viewing for spectators and any television coverage. Double feed/technical assistance zones are strongly recommended.

Article 4. CROSS-COUNTRY ELIMINATOR (XCE) FORMAT

4.2.010 The course for a cross-country eliminator race must be between 500m and 1000m and include natural and/or artificial obstacles, in conformity with article 4.2.009. The whole course must be 100% rideable, single track sections normally are avoided and where possible the course normally has not more than one 180° turn. The start and finish area must be separated in order to allow short race program. Obstacles such as trees, stairs (up/down), drops, bridges or wooden constructions can create a dynamic short race.

4.2.012 The race numbers for the main event are allocated on the basis of the results of the qualifying round, starting with the number 1 for the winner of the qualifying round.

The main event comprises elimination heats in which the groups of riders are matched as shown in the tables in Annexes 5 - XCE competition formats. Heat order: – men first until women come to equal heat system; – finals: women small

final followed by; – men small final followed by women big final and followed by men big final. Intentional contact by pushing, pulling or other means which causes another competitor to slow down, fall or exit the course is not allowed and results in disqualification for breach of UCI rules (DSQ) of the originator.

At the sole discretion of the commissaires' panel, a rider can be announced relegated (REL) and will be given a heat position different to that of his actual finish. Riders who are DNF, DSQ or DNS in the semi-finals may not enter the small final.

The final classification of the competition is drawn up in groups in the following order:

- 1.** all riders competing in the big final, except for riders DSQ.
- 2.** all riders competing in the small final, except for riders DSQ.
- 3.** riders DNF or DNS in the semi-finals.
- 4.** the classification of the other riders is determined by the round reached, then by the classification in their heat, then by their race number.

BMX Racing Competition Format

6.1.021 During all Phases of a BMX Racing event, heats consisting of eight or less riders form the basic unit of competition.

Following riders confirmation, the riders confirmed in each category shall be seeded into a number of heats of at most eight riders, as defined in Annex 1. In case two or more categories were combined together as described in articles 6.1.012 and 6.1.013, it is the combined categories that shall be seeded in this way.

 - Final Run – 2 runs each rider. Best run will count. Judges will select which is best of 1st run from the 2nd run.
 - Men: Top 12 athletes to be selected from qualifiers
 - Women: Top 4 athletes to be selected from qualifiers
